## So Many Ways to Explore



### BIRD WATCHING

Over 50 species of birds have been identified in Jasper County including the endangered Red Cockaded Woodpecker, the federally protected Bald Eagle, and many species of concern - the Bachman Sparrow, Wood Thrush, Swainson's Warbler, and Yellowbilled Cuckoo birds.

**B1** » National Forest Service Road (NFS) 1016 beginning at Clay Road off of Highway 16.

**B2** » End NFS 1016 at Fellowship Road.

**B3** » The beginning of NFS 1013 at Clay Road leads into a waterfowl and wading birds area; you will ford the wetland area and be able to turn around at the end of NSF 1013 while enjoying the wetland scenery.

**B4** » End of NFS 1013 which is a turn-around; head back to the beginning of 1013.

**B5** » The beginning of NFS 1032 at Juliette Road off of Highway 83 (10 miles S of Monticello). Park and walk to view the Red Cockaded Woodpecker.

**B6** » End of NFS 1032, which dead ends. Turn around and head back to Highway 83. Turn right to end your experience or turn left to explore the Piedmont National Wildlife Refuge.

**B7** » Piedmont National Wildlife Refuge Office - check in to get sites within their area.

**B8** » Charlie Elliott Wildlife Visitor's Center - check in to get directions to sites within their area.
