**Summary:**

The Jasper County Board of Education held a meeting on July 8, 2020 and formally approved the Board of Education 2020 millage rate of 17.473.

The Jasper County Board of Education 2020 rollback rate is 17.013.

The millage rate of 17.473 approved by the Board of Education is an increase of .460 mils over the rollback rate representing a 2.70 % tax increase.

The Board of Commissioners needs to adopt the Public Schools millage rate approved by the Jasper County Board of Education to allow the Tax Commissioner to Levy the Board of Education tax for the 2020 tax bills.
