Plan/specification for type of fence to be installed and must meet the following: The fe	nce must be at least four
feet high. Fences that are shorter than four feet won't protect small children and pets from	n going out. The distance
between the ground and the bottom of the fence should be greater than 2 inches but no m	ore than 4 inches. This rule
is again for safety purposes so that no one can enter your premises. The gate of your pool	fence must be self-closing
and self-latching. It should also open away from the pool, not towards it. This code is speci	fically for the safety of
swimmers, and the self-closing and self-latching door will keep your kids and pets safe in c	ase you accidently leave
the door open. Also, since the door will open outwards, there is no danger of people bump	oing into the fence door
accidentally. The latch of your gate should be at least 54 inches above the ground or at lea	st 3 inches below the top of
the poolside gate. As long as the latch can be opened by reaching over, it should be placed	on the high end. Having
the latch on the high side of the door is important so that little kids or pets don't have acce	ess to it. If the fence around
your pool is in conjunction with your house, you are required by law to install door alarms	on all doors that open to
the pool area. Door alarms are an excellent safety feature so you know at all times who is	coming in and out of your
pool area. Lastly, any openings in the fence shouldn't have a passage that is larger than a s	phere with a diameter of
four inches. An exception to the fencing requirements would be a swimming pool with a po	owered safety cover that
complies with ASTM F 1346.
